Minutes of Paris Township Trustees

President James Kiko called the meeting to order at 7:00PM at the township hall with Trustees Michael Stewart and James Glavan present.

Approval of Minutes

Mr. Stewart moved to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the last meeting & approve as submitted. Seconded by Mr. Glavan. Approved.

Road Report

Road Superintendent Todd Kirkpatrick reported the 2010 dump truck had the oil pan repaired. He ordered 100 more tons of salt for delivery. The road crew will be doing maintenance on the trucks and equipment. He said plowing of alleys is hard because people park their vehicles on the alleys. There was a discussion of how the Liberty Project was proceeding. Todd met with Carol Toussant and they discussed several issues concerning the cemeteries. The project is moving along very well. Mr. Kiko will contact the Stark County Engineer's office concerning mowing along county roads.
