Minutes of Paris Township Trustees

Held March 16, 2026

President James Kiko called the meeting to order at 7:00PM at the township hall with Trustees Michael Stewart and James Glavan present.

Approval of Minutes

Mr. Stewart moved to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the last meeting & approve as submitted. Seconded by Mr. Glavan. Approved.

Stark County Health Department

Courtney Myers is the new representative for Paris Township from the health department. She has been with the department for 14 years. She said they have been working on the issue of mud on S.R. 30 at Liberty Tire.

Road Report

Road Superintendent Kirkpatrick reported using a hotbox for patching roads. The bridge over Robertsville Ave. is being removed. Mowing along roads continues. More road cones are needed for various issues such as down trees and power lines. The last windstorm caused 15-20 trees downed on roads. Mr. Kiko will inquire about purchasing a grapple bucket for the loader. Sweeping the roads will take place on April 9. Mr. Stewart called the prosecutor's office concerning large equipment on Parks Ave. Mr. Stewart reported having trouble contacting the county engineer to report tree and power line on county roads.

Rose St. Resolution 20-26

Mr. Kiko made a motion, seconded by Mr. Glavan to allow boring under Rose St. Upon a vote, Mr. Stewart - Aye, Mr. Kiko - Aye, Mr. Glavan - Aye. Approved.

Cemetery Mowing Resolution 21-26

Mr. Kiko made a motion, seconded by Mr. Glavan to approve the cemetery and pavilion mowing for 2026 at a cost of \$21,300 from Hurst Limited. Upon a vote, Mr. Stewart - Aye, Mr. Kiko - Aye, Mr. Glavan - Aye. Approved.

Side Lot Program and Nopec Grant

Mr. Kiko is filling out paperwork for the side lot program for a lot next to the Hidden Valley Lake property. He is also working on a NOPEC Grant.

No further business, Mr. Kiko made a motion, seconded by Mr. Glavan to adjourn and pay bills of \$25,622.51. Approved.
