Minutes of Paris Township Trustees

Held April 6, 2026

President James Kiko called the meeting to order at 7:00PM at the township hall with Trustees Michael Stewart and James Glavan present.

Approval of Minutes

Mr. Kiko moved to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the last meeting & approve as submitted. Seconded by Mr. Glavan. Approved.

NOPEC

Aaron Marcovy said he is Paris Township's new NOPEC representative. He reported that information mailed to residents informing them of the rate increase to \$.09999 cents per kilowatt. He said NOPEC's job is the Aggregate, Educate and Advocate for citizens of Paris Township.

Road Report

Road Superintendent Kirkpatrick reported patching continues and the Shelly plant is now open for asphalt. A culvert on Freed St. needs replaced soon. He reported the chip & seal price from 20/20 Enterprises is \$22,000.00 per mile.

NOPEC Grant

Mr. Kiko is working on the NOPEC Grant to receive \$27,445.00 for Paris Township.

Paris Memorial Day Parade

Mr. Stewart said the Paris Community Association decided not to have the Memorial Day Parade in 2026.

Oil & Gas

Mr. Kiko reported EOG Energy wants to unitize Liberty Cemetery into one of their wells. Mr. Kiko will have the prosecutor's office review the contract.

No further business, Mr. Stewart made a motion, seconded by Mr. Glavan to adjourn and pay bills of \$58,020.68. Approved.
