Minutes of Paris Township Trustees

Held April 20, 2026

President James Kiko called the meeting to order at 7:00PM at the township hall with Trustees Michael Stewart and James Glavan present.

Approval of Minutes

Mr. Stewart moved to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the last meeting & approve as submitted. Seconded by Mr. Glavan. Approved.

Road Report

Road Superintendent Kirkpatrick reported getting an estimate of \$12,901.90 for a 22KW generator from Ray Electric. The generator would be purchased from funds from a grant. Patching continues. A driveway culvert was replaced on Telpahak St. Cemetery mowing will be on Thursdays. The 2020 Int. truck has an air leak that needs fixed. Mowing along roads also continues. Robertsville Ave. should be open in two weeks. Mr. Kiko reported that the railroad bridge embankments would be removed. Woodale Ave. was surveyed. Mr. Kirkpatrick will figure which roads are to be chip & sealed and which are to be asphalted. Mr. Stewart reported the prosecutor's office drove Parks Ave. to see the damage done by the county engineer. Mr. Stewart also contacted county commissioner Bill Smith concerning the matter. The county engineer is to review a video of Parks Ave. before the damage was done.

NOPEC Grant Resolution 22-26

Mr. Kiko made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stewart to apply for a NOPEC Grant. Upon a vote, Mr. Stewart - Aye, Mr. Kiko - Aye, Mr. Glavan - Aye. Approved.

Paris Square Dance

Mr. Stewart said the Paris Community Association decided to have a square dance on May 24 from 6:30 to 10:00 at the Paris Pavilion.

No further business, Mr. Glavan made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stewart to adjourn and pay bills of \$30,722.60. Approved.
