Minutes of Paris Township Trustees

Held July 6, 2026

President James Kiko called the meeting to order at 7:00PM at the township hall with Trustee Michael Stewart present.

Approval of Minutes

Mr. Stewart moved to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the last meeting & approved as submitted. Seconded by Mr. Kiko. Approved.

Road Report

Road Superintendent Todd Kirkpatrick reported five burials since the last meeting. The Liberty Cemetery roads need sealed. The road crew began spreading asphalt. Two dump trucks were repaired. There were trees down on several roads that needed cut up. Freed St. and Freedmont St. have been bermed and ditched. Mr. Stewart said he has contacted the engineer's office again concerning the damage to Stucky St. The engineer's office has not responded to his call. Mr. Stewart reported that Parks Ave. is shutdown while a railroad bridge is being removed. He will contact Osnaburg Trustee Pero concerning the shutdown.

Paris Community Association

Mr. Stewart reported that the prosecutor's office said the Paris Community Assoc. should donate their assets to Paris Township. The Paris Community Assoc. has not made a final decision concerning moving forward or not as of this date.

Fences

Mr. Kiko reported that old fence lines can be removed by the township and the cost accessed to the landowner.

Road Levy

The road levy will be tabled until the next meeting.
